RECHARGE Scheme

You have the power!



The **RECHARGE scheme** is a MetroAccess Initiative in partnership with local businesses and Mobility Aids Australia Pty Ltd. The RECHARGE Scheme is an ongoing scheme being implemented throughout the state of Victoria.

The RECHARGE scheme is a simple and effective means of ensuring that people who use an electric scooter or wheelchair can travel without the fear of being stranded by a flat battery.

It's about encouraging local businesses to provide a power point so customers can recharge their battery at their business, if required.

How do I get involved as a mobility aid user?

As a user of a mobility aid you can take advantage of your local RECHARGE points in Darebin and neighbouring Councils to recharge your battery and stay out in the community longer.

To locate your nearest RECHARGE point you can log onto the RECHARGE FINDER website www.rechargescheme.org.au or contact your Darebin MetroAccess Officer, contact details listed on the back.

RECHARGE stickers are visible on participating shop fronts so you can easily identify local businesses involved. The RECHARGE logo is placed above/near power points so you can easily recognise which power point has been set aside for use. All RECHARGE logos and associated information are consistent so everyone can recognise this initiative wherever they live, work or visit in Victoria.

If you have an onboard charger, this means you already have your charger with you and can recharge at any business affiliated with the RECHARGE Scheme. If you have a separate charger, you need to remember to take it with you.

How do I get involved as an interested business?

To become a RECHARGE program partner, local businesses need to be physically accessible (step free entrance) and willing to provide a power point. On becoming a program partner you will receive the easily identifiable promotional material and an information pack.

The only ongoing commitment to your business then is the cost of electricity to recharge an electric scooter or wheelchair, which will be less than 20 cents per hour. Even if the power point offered is not used, remember that it is the participation of your business in the scheme that is giving people the confidence to get about, knowing support is available.
